

Poonam Bala, Ph.D.(Commonwealth Scholar) from the University of Edinburgh, UK, M.Phil. from Jawaharlal Nehru University, Master's and undergraduate degrees from Miranda House, University of Delhi. She is currently **Professor Extraordinarius** at UNISA (South Africa) and Visiting Scholar at Cleveland State University (USA) with post-doctoral research from the Wellcome Institute/University of London (UK), University College London (UCL) and University of Edinburgh, with a recent Fellowship at IASH (UK). She is former Faculty- Delhi School of Economics, a Visiting Professor- Jawaharlal Nehru University, at UNISA (South Africa), and at universities in Germany, Canada and Greece. She has lectured at Harvard University, University of Queensland and delivered the **Distinguished Dr. Upendranath Brahmachari Endowment Lecture** at the University of Burdwan. She has published extensively on the social history of Indian medicine, and is the author/editor of about a dozen books and several research articles, in national and international journals. Her books have been published by reputed publishers including Sage, Routledge/Taylor & Francis, Bloomsbury and Lexington Books. She was a Keynote Speaker at the first International Conference on Medicine and Society (Bengal), and has lectured and presented at various conferences in the US, India, UK, South Africa and Australia. Besides, she was President of the First International Conference on Ancient Greek and Indian Medicine (Greece), and Founding Member of the Asian Indian Heritage Project (Ohio), has been on the Editorial Board of the *Ancient Science of Life*, on the Editorial/Reviewers' Board of the *Athens Journal of Health*, and Academic Member of *Athens Journal of History*, and invited Consultant to Workshop on Globalisation of Ayurveda, University of Cambridge, UK.
